Weightage Criteria for Admission Process:

1. All the Candidates who have applied for the M.Sc. Finance Course online are called for Scrutiny of Original Documents as per the schedule displayed on website

AND

- 2. All Eligible Candidates will have to go through the Selection Process of Group Discussion (GD) followed by Personal Interview (PI), conducted by SIMSREE on same days, as per the schedule displayed on the SIMSREE website, and the weightages will be as follows:-

The Final Merit Score (FMS) is Calculated as per the above weightages for the admission to M.Sc. Finance Course.
